### Abstract

This thesis presents the Description of Moklen, a Malayo-Polynesian language in Thailand, on its phonology and syntax. The data were obtained from the Moklen found at Lam-Pee, Amphoe Thai-Muang, Phangnga Province.

The phonological part consists of the Intonation Group, the stress Group, the Syllable, the Phoneme and Resegmentation. The syntactical part consists of word, phrase, clause and sentence levels.
